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### **Description and General Notes**

**If the SHU Fits** shares voices of the victims of solitary confinement telling their stories. Included are excerpts of letters, blog entries, government reports, and speeches of family members, all organized into a Reader's Theatre Format. The script published here is designed to be flexible, and we have not designated assigned roles. You may choose to change the order, to eliminate and/or add material.

We feel it can be presented in as informal setting as a living room or church committee meeting to a full-blown production in a theatre. We have kept it short (it runs about 50 minutes), as a tool to facilitate discussion of the issues presented and action to be taken.

We strongly urge any presentation of **If the SHU Fits** to be supplemented by some follow-up - a panel or individual presentations, or participation in a letter-writing, advocacy, and/or direct action campaigns.
